USDA Designates Allamakee and Winneshiek Counties as Disaster Areas Due to Drought

A Secretarial Disaster Designation has been issued for one (1) county in Minnesota as a primary disaster area for drought. Additionally, two (2) Iowa counties are contiguous to the disaster area. This determination will allow the Farm Service Agency's Emergency Loans to be made available to eligible family farmers with qualifying production and physical losses in the primary and the contiguous counties to the declared disaster area.

Secretarial Declaration Number: S5498

Emergency Loan Application Deadline: April 22, 2024

Primary Counties Eligible: Primary county located in Minnesota

Contiguous Counties Also Eligible: Allamakee and Winneshiek (Iowa)

Disaster Description: Drought. June 27, 2023 beginning date of incident period.
