Beginning producers can face many challenges getting started, and Danni has had her fair share of setbacks. However, she's accustomed to the daily nuances of farm life. The farm loan process is difficult, and she wishes the loan information wasn't misleading. Time is a precious commodity for farmers. Traveling an hour to the local service center isn't convenient, especially since farming isn't her only job. Danni needs clear information that will outline the farm loan process and reduce her service center visits.

Frustrations

- The FSA site minimizes the preparation producers need when considering a funding option. There isn't enough information on the eligibility requirements or financial documents for producers beginning their farm loan program journey.
- Locating the correct link requires too may steps. The click-intensive journey makes it difficult to find specific information.
- She would like to save time and complete their farm loan application with confidence instead of having to frequently contact and visit the local service center for assistance.
- Danni gets overwhelmed and frustrated by the excessive use of acronyms and technical jargon on the FSA site.

Needs

- Time is precious for Danni. She needs fewer and more efficient trips to her local service center.
- Danni is a beginning woman farmer. She needs to feel represented and included within the farming community.
- The loan and application processes are tedious and complex.

- Danni usually spends her day working on the farm away from her desk. She needs to be able to easily access the site on her mobile device.

Goals

- Would like to find funding to purchase extra equipment and hire workers for expanding farming operations.
- Would like to take the additional steps to become certified as an organic farmer.

Tasks

- Harvest and collect ripe fruit from the field and transport it to the farm stand.
- Ensure the fruit has cooled to an ambient temperature before filling up fruit baskets.
- Make sure all baskets are at a good weight and filled to capacity before being transferred to the cooler.
- Spread the word about her fruit farm by leveraging social media to post about upcoming farmers markets & events.
